 - Capital project: received 3.4 million through leg sessions for capital projec to est. BIPOC community healing hub in snohomish county
 - Submitted property purchase and sale agreement for 1.1 mi for commercial space off of Beverly blvd in everett
 - If successful in securing property, will be about 1 year before opening and becoming operational
